2 OPENING REMARKS

- •We are continuing in our study of prophecy in the Book of Revelation
- •We have just started studying in the 13th chapter
- Chapter 13 is a continuation of chapter 12
- Last week we read verses 1 and 2
- •We'll re-read verses 1 and 2 and then continue into verse 3

3 SATAN BECOMES A MAN

Revelation 13:1-3

1 And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.

2 And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

•As we read this we found that the same 3 animals are used to describe the empire of the Antichrist, the leopard, the bear and the lion, that Daniel used in chapter 7

4 SYMBOLS EXPLAINED

- In Revelation John is seeing the world empires as past and Daniel is seeing them as future
- •This is why the order of the animal symbols are reversed in Revelation from that which is in Daniel
- Daniel used the lion, the bear and the leopard as symbols of the 3 world empires that preceded the Roman Empire
- The beast was the symbol Daniel used for the Roman Empire and this symbol stays the same throughout the Scriptures which follows

the rules of Biblical prophecy

 When the Roman Empire is in its final form it will include all the other empires

5 SYMBOLS EXPLAINED cont.

- "Sands of the sea" is a symbol of the masses of people
- The rise of dictators and powerful conquerors from the common people and the revival of a strong national spirit may be the horns of the beast rising above the level of the waters
- The symbol applies both to the man and his empire
- This is also true of Daniel's symbols
- •The dragon had crowns on his heads; Satan has always ruled over nations, but in the end time the crowns are on the horns
- The horns represent the nations that will make up the nucleus of Antichrist's kingdom

6 SYMBOLS EXPLAINED cont.

- When this beast rises out of the sea (which usually represents humanity), six of the seven heads are history; they no longer wear crowns
- •Six world empires: Assyria, Egypt, Babylon, Persia, Greece, Rome
- The Roman Empire nucleus was 10 countries around the Mediterranean Sea
- •The crowns are on the seventh head and this is the one with which we will be dealing with from now on
- Remember this is after the Rapture, the saints are in heaven, Satan his fallen angels are cast out of heaven to this earth; from the spiritual world to the material world

7 SATAN IN PERSON

Revelation 13:1-3

3 And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast.

• Here we see something strange happening to this head

- •John saw one of the heads as though it "were wounded to death"
- There are a number of Scriptures that use adverbial phrases and preparatory subjects such as: "like as of", "as it were", "like unto"

8 SYMBOLS EXPLAINED cont.

- •The seven heads represent the seven human governments from the beginning of time to the end of time
- Remember the number seven in the Scriptures means "complete"
- Of the seven governments we have had six; the seventh we are going into
- Keeping in mind the seven heads represent all human government of all time, then one head represents human government at one given time
- This head that was wounded represents the man in power at the time that Satan is cast down to earth

9 SATAN'S COUNTERFEIT

- •This head appears "as though it were wounded to death"
- •This man appears like he should be dead but yet he lives
- •This is Satan's counterfeit of the Resurrection which has just taken place
- Satan has created counterfeits down through the ages such as the tares, false churches, false doctrines, false teachers, etc.
- It is only with a strong and sincere desire for the truth will God show us the difference between the counterfeit and the real, the tares and the wheat
- •Only God knows the intents of our hearts

10 SATAN'S COUNTERFEIT cont.

- •Only God knows if we really want the truth
- •Do we really want God as He is, not what we imagine Him to be?
- If we do, God will show us the difference between the tares, the imitation/counterfeit, and what is really from Him
- God would never allow Satan to separate us from Him unless we allow him to

- With the appearance of a resurrection, Satan's draws the attention of the world away from the wonders of the Rapture and toward his own supposed miraculous power
- •Satan's powers are only as great as God allows them to be

11 SATAN'S COUNTERFEIT cont.

Daniel 11:20, 14

20 Then shall stand up in his estate a raiser of taxes in the glory of the kingdom: but within few days he shall be destroyed, neither in anger, nor in battle.

14 And in those times there shall many stand up against the king of the south: also the robbers of thy people shall exalt themselves to establish the vision; but they shall fall.

- •It doesn't matter what Satan does, his end result is going to be the same
- He fools multitudes of people today and he will fool them in that day also
- •We find here that this deadly wound is healed but we are not told how he. Antichrist, received this wound

12 THE ADVENT OF ANTICHRIST

- Verse 14 indicates that the wound is to be by a sword
- •This death is not murder but it is a spectacular death
- This man, at this time, is the most powerful man in the world as he is able to bring a semblance of peace
- Every eye on earth will be on this man because he seems to be able to something that we have not been able to reach for a number of years and that is this semblance of peace and prosperity
- •We knew as long as there was prosperity Antichrist wouldn't rise
- For Antichrist to take control and Satan to come and take this man's body, the world had to be in a chaotic state; a state of near depression and continuous warfare

13 SATAN RULING IN PERSON

- •The state of the world has to be bad enough that the world willingly gives their authority and rule to him
- From this point on, when Satan takes over this man's body, Satan is ruling in person
- Until this time Satan's rule has been in a spiritual form, now he is manifest in the material world
- The man Antichrist turns himself willingly over to Satan before Satan is cast out of heaven
- Satan is ruling through this man already by the time he takes over his body
- Although Antichrist will be Satan in the flesh and will be completely possessed by Satan, he will have a separate personality of his own

14 WORSHIP OF THE DRAGON

- In the end, Satan will be cast into the bottomless pit, while Antichrist will be cast into the lake of fire
- •The world will recognize Antichrist as Satan and worship him anyway
- •There has been at times confusion between the man and the empire
- In Daniel it shows the empire and then it changes over to the man but it is still the same thing
- •All prophecy follows the same pattern in this respect: it starts with the history of empires showing their rise and fall till the final form of world domination is reached
- •Then the pronoun changes from it to he, and a man becomes fulfillment of the symbol; he become the strength

15 THE ADVENT OF ANTICHRIST

- •The whole earth is looking towards the man who becomes all powerful when Satan takes up his abode in him
- This is why you cannot separate the empire from the man until we reach the end of time
- When this pronoun changes from it to he, this man becomes the beast instead of just the empire
- •This is true in Daniel as well as Revelation

- The head when it is wounded, that is the time when Satan is cast out down to the earth
- This wound will probably be a self-inflicted wound
- •Satan enters into this man's body when the man appears to be dead

16 THE ADVENT OF ANTICHRIST cont.

- Then Satan raises him up in what appears to be miraculous resurrection
- It is at this moment the the pronoun changes from it to him
- •The man becomes stronger then the empires he's ruling
- The world today is experiencing "the stress of nations, with perplexity."
- The transgressors must come to the full for the Antichrist to be able to step in and take over (Daniel 8:23)
- The head that is wounded and restored is Antichrist

17 THE ADVENT OF ANTICHRIST cont.

- •The man, up until this time, has already established himself over an empire when Satan takes over his body
- With the world conditions as they are, if one man rises up and seems able to solve the world's problems, then that will be set up as ruler
- •This is how Antichrist comes into power
- Daniel does not recognize the empire of Antichrist, but only the man
- •The so-called death and resurrection of this man is the means by which Satan receives a body
- •This happens right after the Rapture

18 THE ADVENT OF ANTICHRIST cont.

- •This man Antichrist will probably be recognized but not take power before the Rapture
- •The Bible is more authentic than any history ever written as it was written ahead of time by God
- •We know what to look for, the signs of Jesus coming, and we need to keep the in the forefront of our minds

- •Knowing this Bible, the Word of God, and seeing the happenings in the world today, this should make us vigilant in studying the Word and looking for His coming
- We are certainly seeing the "distress of nations, with perplexity..." (Luke 21:25)

19 THE ADVENT OF ANTICHRIST cont.

- Knowing the Word of God makes us rejoice: for the fulfillment of prophecy and His soon returning
- God will bring true and everlasting peace
- •We have to wonder if this will be our last study as some day it will be
- Are the world leaders going to be able to bring back again that lull before the storm?
- Antichrist will have to be risen up and in power before Satan takes over his body
- It is probable that the rise of the beast with the crown on his horns will precede the Rapture
- According to Daniel, this man he calls the little horn, he shall rise up and conquer three nations

20 THE ADVENT OF ANTICHRIST cont.

- Daniel puts this before the heavenly scene that corresponds with Revelation 4 and 5
- •So it is likely that saints living in the last days will see the rise of the man we call Antichrist
- At one time there was a belief that Henry Kissinger was the Antichrist due to his name meaning 666 derived by some complicated formula
- We will not need a formula or anything complicated in order to recognize the Antichrist
- Mankind tries to fit events and occurrences into Scripture where it does not fit
- •When it is God's timing and prophecy is fulfilled, there will be no doubt about it

21 THE ADVENT OF ANTICHRIST cont.

- •God's people will understand and the event, occurrence or person will fit exactly
- •The next prophetic event is the rise of this man we call Antichrist
- •We do not know how Antichrist conquers the three countries
- •Alice firmly believes that we will recognize when this man begins to ascend in his power
- Antichrist will have a power to unify

22 WORSHIP OF THE DRAGON

Revelation 13:4-6

4 And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him?

5 And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months.

6 And he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme his name, and his tabernacle, and them that dwell in heaven.
