Genesis 1:1-31 God's 6 Creative Days

1. In view of:

Psalms 90:4 – “For a thousand years in the sight are but as yesterday when it is past, and as a watch in the night.”

2 Peter 3:8 – “But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.”
